*If you were able to get the plastic Easter eggs, take them apart and use a permanent marker to write the uppercase letter on the larger half of the egg and the lowercase letter on the smaller half. Mix them up and have your child match the letters.To make it harder don't match the colors mix them so the uppercase and lowercase letters are different colored eggs.

*The Friday art project requires a paint canvas but you can also use a poster board. You can purchase them at The Dollar Store or Walmart.
